NAME of activity	Painting on a cover
duration	1h
audience	from 5 to 18. 10 children max
Pedagogical goal	Build a big drawing together, with respect to the rules (as symetry). Respect each one's space of expression.
Description	Ex: Mandala of the sea. The transparent tarpaulin is put on the ground. We draw a big circle on it with a chalk (or woad). Then a little drawing in the middle (for instance a fish). Children make drawings, around this centre, in a symetrical way. Little by little, they fill the whole circle, from the centre to the sides.
Material	1 transparent tarpaulin Pastel Crayons
Space	Space to lie the tarpaulin and to pass around.
Comments	Turn the tarpaulin upside down after painting, so you can walk on it. Be careful, the chalk can stain clothes.
Restitution	The painted tarpaulin can be used as a carpet for a show (so we can play with figures), or be fixed on a wall.
